Objectives

Strategy

Strengthen capability and leadership of member organisations

- Build ACCO sector skills and broker partnerships to increase ACCO-led service delivery
- Catalyse initiatives to empower community members e.g. EKILD, Empowered Young Leaders (EYL) and EK mentoring initiative
- Build data capability and leadership in member organisations for informed decision making
- Opt-in organisations have robust/ shared data capacity
- East Kimberley Aboriginal people increasingly take action

Build and formalise partnerships to implement the Regional Development Agenda (RDA)

- Co-design an investment plan to implement the RDA and Early Years RDA
- Co-design and mobilise Regional Partnership Table
- Adapt and strengthen EC governance structures for Aboriginal-led development

- Opt-in organisations increase scope/type of collaborative work
- Opt-in organisations and partners increasingly work with BBY for initiative support, strategic guidance and leadership

Improve sustainability as a strong and trusted

Backbone

- Succession planning for Board and CEO
- Reduce reliance on NIAA funding
- Independent review of ECEK
- Develop data infrastructure to enable data ownership and access

• Backbone organisational maturity

Increase ECEK influence through advocacy and systems change

- Data access and partnerships
- Use local data to underpin advocacy and reshape policy landscape
- Increase influence on Commonwealth and State policy and investment
- Shape and participate in Kimberley regional governance

- Funders are redirecting funds to support EC goals
- Target audiences advocate for changes to the system aligned with initiative goals
