### **About BBY**

BBY is the backbone organisation for the Aboriginal-designed and led Empowered Communities initiative in the East Kimberley. BBY provides a collective voice for 25 member organisations and aims to help its members empower Aboriginal individuals and families to achieve positive economic, social and cultural development.

Empowered Communities in the East Kimberley aims to achieve the following 5 'Social Norms':

1. Adults go to work or are in training;
2. We care for children, old people and the vulnerable;
3. Children go to school and are ready to learn;
4. People take personal responsibility and do not commit crimes;
5. People look after their homes and pay rent.

### **Director Eligibility Requirements**

BBY is seeking regional leaders with vision, drive and leadership experience to play a key role in the governance of BBY. To be eligible to apply, you must satisfy the following criteria:

- be at least 18 years old;
- be an Aboriginal person;
- live in the East Kimberley;
- have knowledge of the issues impacting Aboriginal people in the East Kimberley;
- be aligned with the Social Norms listed above;
- agree to become a member of BBY for 2 years; and
- not be disqualified from managing a corporation.

The successful applicant must be available to attend 4 scheduled board meeting per annum, the BBY Annual General Meeting and otherwise attend to board matters between meetings as required.
